Coach's Code of Conduct

The Asahi baseball association is committed to providing excellence in both its coaching staff and program design and as such, the Asahi Baseball Association and its coaches commit to the follow:

- Coaches will inspect the facilities and equipment before training sessions and competition and take steps to ensure deficiencies are corrected immediately, or adjust the activity(s) accordingly, in order to avoid risk.
- 2. Coaches will have in their immediate possession the emergency numbers for each athlete and parent, and letters of medical permission (Emergency Consent Form).
- 3. Coaches will communicate with the parent of each player to be sure that they are fully aware of medical conditions and learning challenges for each athlete.
- 4. Coaches will remove any player from training or playing if they believe the player may be at further risk injury due to past or recent injuries.
- 5. Coaches will communicate with parents who have concerns about their child in a professional and respectful manner
- 6. Coaches will respect the concerns of the players and listen to their ideas and comments.
- 7. Coaches will refrain from any violent, abusive, and demeaning actions towards the players
- 8. Coaches will refrain from using foul language, making derogatory and sexist comments
