The parent(s), by signing this agreement, agrees to:

- remember that their child plays for his or her enjoyment, not their own.
- always encourage their child to play by the rules.
- respect and show appreciation for other club members, volunteers and coaches
- refrain from coaching their child or other players during games and practices, unless they are one of the official coaches of the team.
- will always address any questions or concerns to the coaches or officials at the appropriate time, defined as after games or practices and away from the players.
- Monitor their own expectations of their child's performance and progress, realizing that athletes who feel they cannot meet parents' expectations, quickly lose motivation.
- Demonstrate respectful behavior towards coaching staff, other club members and athletes.
- All parents are encouraged to raise any concerns they may have to the appropriate staff or club member. However, it is essential that this be done in a calm, polite and respectful manner.
- Commit to the specified fundraising activities that form part of the overall program.
- Support team and club sponsors and follow through on mandatory volunteerism club events.
- Pay all fees and in a prompt, timely and complete manner.
